Happy Spring everyone! Hope all is well with you all. I have been busy since our last meeting with preparation for the Pre-Conference Assembly and working on updates to the area's registration list.

I was very encouraged with the attendance by our GSR's at the assembly. I counted 10 GSR's from this district, which is a record for this rotation! One of the things talked about, and voted on, at the assembly was with regards to the assistance from Area for GSR's to attend the assemblies. I would like to remind everyone that we have a provision to assistance for GSR's here as well in our budget and in our guidelines.
