At this time, I would like to move that the DCMC budget be increased to \$1500 for this year. That would allot \$183.20 towards November assembly expenses. If the expenses exceed that amount, I would consider that a 7th Tradition donation.

As requested, I have also prepared information regarding PRAASA for next year which will be discussed later in the agenda.
