Hi everyone! I hope everyone is doing well.

DCMC activities this month have been light. I did get an email from a gentleman who is up on the reservation interested in participating in some remote communities work. He is working on getting meetings going and supporting meetings up on the Hopi reservation. I have connected him and Keith together and hope that we can determine what support he needs so that we can continue to be reaching out to alcoholics in that area.

I have been working on preparing for the post-conference assembly which is this weekend in Globe. The purpose of the Post Conference assembly is for the Delegate to return from the Conference at GSO and report back to the Area on the activities that occurred during the conference. I am always amazed at how our voices are carried at that level and how GSO takes into consideration every single group's conscience in making decisions that affect AA as a Whole. If you have never heard a delegates report, I highly encourage you to make every effort to attend.

Convention planning is moving forward. I have a separate written report.

Please continue to think about what you may be interested in doing for next rotation and talk to folks in those positions that interest you. Elections will be here before we know it.

For financial accounting, I have no regular DCMC expenses for this last month. In looking towards Post Conference expenses, I am sharing my room in Globe again with another DCM from Phoenix. The estimated cost will be in the range of about \$100 for my share of the room. I am also estimating mileage to be around 454 miles round trip which will be around \$146. Total estimated expenses will be in the area of \$246, give or take for taxes. Remaining funds in the DCMC budget are estimated to then be \$438.65. For forward thinking, given the next two assemblies are farther from Flagstaff (August in Tucson and November in Yuma), I am concerned that my budget may not be sufficient to cover expenses. I will keep an eye on this and will report to the district as we get closer to each assembly.

With regards to the Additional Pacific Regional Forum, I have purchased my plane ticket which was a few cents shy of \$150. Remaining budget amount for that stands are \$250 to cover my airport transfers in LA and hotel. I am sharing my room at the Forum already so that will help to reduce the cost.
