Hi everyone! I hope everyone is doing well

I apologize for not being able to be at the meeting this month. I have to do my quarterly "North Run" to Page this week and was not able to schedule that prior or after the district meeting.

DCMC activities continue to be somewhat light. I have fielded traditions questions this month from a couple of folks and am still planning to attend the Women's meeting in Williams and the Women's Solutions meetings once those groups decide on a date to discuss service and service positions. I attended the Post Conference assembly. Expense listing is below. I have already been reimbursed for my expenses. I will be attending the Admin and Agenda meetings this Sunday the 17th. Expenses for this meeting is covered by the Area.

Regarding the Workshop, at the post conference assembly I spoke to Dee P., the Alternate Area Chair and Jeff F., the Area CPC coordinator about presenting at our workshop. Both agreed to present on "GSR 101" and "Anonymity in the Digital Age". I have suggested that if there is another presenter, maybe someone from Intergroup would be a good fit. If the district decides that it wants to go in a different direction for the workshop and not have these two folks come up, I will need to know right away to notify them.

The August Assembly is in Tucson August 26-29. If you have not yet registered, I urge you to do so. Also, the Additional Pacific Regional Forum is coming up the weekend prior to the assembly. This is open to any AA member and there is no registration cost. If you are interested in getting more information, you can contact me or go to www.aa.org and under services for members, there will be a link to Regional forums. I will be attending the Forum and have already secured my plane ticket and will be sharing the room with another member. If anyone is wanting to go and needs a ride to the Airport, I will be driving down very early on Friday morning but won't be coming back up to Flagstaff until the following Monday morning as my flight lands later in the evening on Sunday.

For financial accounting, my expenses for the Post-Conference assembly were \$86.77 for the hotel and \$156.80 (490 miles total) for mileage for total reimbursement of \$243.57. Remaining DCMC budget is \$441.08.

For future financial planning purposes, I am sharing a room in Tucson with another DCM so hotel costs will be approximately \$80 and mileage is estimated at 540 miles for mileage costs of \$172.80 for total projected expenses of \$252.80. I am available to ride share if anyone would like to ride with me. I plan to leave early on Friday morning and won't be back until later on Sunday afternoon due to meeting commitments that I have at the assembly. This will leave \$188.28 left in the DCMC budget.

With regards to the 2011 State Convention, we had our last planning meeting on the 10th. We really need everyone to get the word out about the convention and to encourage folks to pre-register. Shirts and cups are being sold by pre-registration only so please let people know that if they want souvenirs, they need to get them now. Please take fliers to your meetings, announce in your meetings and try to get folks to commit to going. We have lots of activities happening, great speakers planned, displays from Archives, Literature and Grapevine available, and we know that

it is going to be an awesome time. Registration is required to attend the event, so if you are planning to go, please get your registration in early.

Since we are gearing up, our meetings are now going to be every 2 weeks. The dates are July 24th 1pm at the Alano, August 6th 1pm at the Alano, August 20th at the Alano, September 3rd 1pm at the Alano (Which will include the packet stuffing for the pre-registered folks), and then an on-site meeting at the Radisson on September 6th at 5:30pm. I am looking for someone to be willing to be our volunteer coordinator, so if anyone is interested, please let me know.
